## Internet Access, Past Year Health-Related Use of the Internet, and Interest in Selected IT Modalities for Health Education

### Estimates from the 2005 Kaiser Permanente NCal Region Adult Member Health Survey

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#### This presentation will:

- 1. Provide a brief overview of the methodology of the 2005 KP-NCal Adult Member Health Survey
- 2. Show estimated IT access (personal computer, Internet, and email) by age and gender and level of education
- 3. Show estimated use of Kaiser and non-Kaiser websites during the 12 months prior to the survey to communicate with the health care system and seek health-related information, by age and gender and level of education.
- 4. Show estimated interest in using IT technologies to learn about health and how to take care of oneself, by age and gender and level of education.


#### MHS Study Design:

- Separate samples pulled for 19 KP-NCal Medical Center Service Populations (MCSP) based on outpatient use during 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2004 or administrative assignment if no outpatient utilization.
- MCSP samples consist of 2,100+ men and women aged ≥ 20, stratified by 5 age groups (20-44, 45-64, 65-74, 75-79, 80+); larger samples for 5 facilities with high estimated %s members of color (OAK, RCH, SFO, HAY, VAL)
- Eligibility criteria: Current member, not LEP (survey only available in English); LOE and utilization history not considered
- Survey mailed in April 2005, with up to 2 mailed follow-ups
- Survey respondents assigned a post-stratification weighting factor based on age-gender composition of MCSP and of final respondent sample → Weighted samples better reflect agegender compositions of the MCSP (and Region)

### In 2005, web-based survey option offered in addition to hardcopy survey:

- Designed to appeal to younger adults who have always been our worst responders; most adults > 65 not expected to choose electronic questionnaire option
- Survey packet (questionnaire, cover letter + FAQ, return envelope) sent out to entire sample. URL of web-based survey, logon ID and passcode included in the letter
  - Couldn't send out an e-mail link because we do not have members' e-mail addresses, but KP-NCal IRB would likely not have approved contacting members by e-mail anyway.
- Only 2.4% (454 / 18,750) of survey respondents chose to complete the survey on our secure website: 6.4% (n=132) men 25-44, 3.5% women 25-44 (n=132), and 3.9% of men 45-64 (n=104); <1% of men and women aged ≥ 65 chose web option


#### 2005 Member Health Survey Response Rates, Overall and by Age-Gender Group






### Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 with PC, Internet and E-mail Access from Home or Other Location, 2005




#### Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 with Internet Access from Home or Home/Other Location, 2005




#### Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 with E-mail Access from Home or Home/Other Location, 2005



## Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 with Internet Access from Home or Other Location, by Age and Gender, 2005




## Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 with Internet Access from Home or Other Location, by Education, 2005





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


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
## Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 with Internet Access from Home or Other Location, by Race/Ethnicity, 2005




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




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


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
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
## Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 Who Got Health Information or Advice from an Internet Website During the Past Year, 2005




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
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


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

## Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 Interested in Multi-Session Health Education Programs Using E-Mail or Internet, 2005




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


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## Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 Interested in Using a Computer-Based Program to Learn About Taking Care of Their Health, 2005






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## Percentages of KP-NCal Members Aged 25-79 Interested in Multi-Session Health Education Programs Done Over the Phone, 2005




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
